This series, located in the Reference Section of the Library (Call # H62.O66, then alphabetical by title), has, as its stated purpose, "to present balance, and often difficult to find, opposing points of view on complex and sensitive issues. .... A persuasive case for considering opposing viewpoints has been presented by John Stuart Mill in his work *On Liberty*. When examining controversial issues it may be helpful to reflect on this suggestion:

The only way in which a human being can make some approach to knowing the whole of a subject, is by hearing what can be said about it by persons of every variety of opinion, and studying all modes in which it can be looked at by every character of mind. No wise man ever acquired his wisdom in any mode but this."

## How to Cite Encyclopedia Articles in MLA Format.

When citing familiar reference books (such as the New Catholic Encyclopedia), do not give full publication information. For such work, list only the edition (if stated) and the year of publication.

Example:

Nolan, P. "Free Will." The New Catholic Encyclopedia. 2<sup>nd</sup> ed. 2002.

When citing less familiar reference books, however, especially those that have appeared in only one edition, give full publication information. Note: when no author is listed at the end of the article, the title of the article (as in the first example below) is the first item in the citation and is alphabetized accordingly in the "Works Cited" page.

Examples:

"Animal Liberation Front (ALF) (Great Britain)." Encyclopedia of Modern Worldwide Extremists and Extremist Groups. Ed. Stephen E. Atkins. Westport, CT: Greenhaven Press, 2004.

Tong, Rosemarie. "Reproductive Technologies: Surrogacy." Encyclopedia of Bioethics. Ed. Warren T. Reich. Rev. ed. 5 vols. New York: Simon & Schuster Macmillan, 1995.
