This series, located in the Reference Section of the Library (Call # H62.O66, then alphabetical by title), has, as its stated purpose, “to present balance, and often difficult to find, opposing points of view on complex and sensitive issues. . . . A persuasive case for considering opposing viewpoints has been presented by John Stuart Mill in his work *On Liberty*. When examining controversial issues it may be helpful to reflect on this suggestion:

The only way in which a human being can make some approach to knowing the whole of a subject, is by hearing what can be said about it by persons of every variety of opinion, and studying all modes in which it can be looked at by every character of mind. No wise man ever acquired his wisdom in any mode but this.”
